## **Employment: Basics**



### What are US employers looking for?

- US-based work experience (1+ year)
- Positive US-based references
- Resumes, 2 pages *maximum* (not CVs)
- Experience with the skills needed
  - English proficiency is not necessary for stabilization employment
- Ability to pass drug test, show up on time reliably
- Benefit to the company



## **Employment: Common Job Types**

### Stabilization employment

- Common experience: "down shift" from prior positions
- Goal: gain US-based work experience, earn income for basic living expenses


### **Career Pathways**

- Common experience: prior education not recognized in the US, or the return to your field of expertise will take a significant financial and time re-investment
- Goal: begin/ re-start journey to higher-skill, higher-wage positions
